Food & Beverage

• Cafeteria, ext. 2217

Our cafeteria is located off the lobby in Irving Cypen Tower (ICT) and is open daily 11am - 2pm for lunch. Dinner is not served in the cafeteria.

The Café is located in the May Visitors Welcome Center and is open daily from 8am - 4pm, for breakfast and treats.
